### **Hooters 250 Fast Facts**

- The Hooters 250 will be the 16<sup>th</sup> time the Hooters Pro Cup Series has competed at Jennerstown Speedway, dating back to the inaugural race in 2001.
- In 15 Hooters Pro Cup races at Jennerstown Speedway, there have been 10 different winners. Only Benny Gordon, Jeff Agnew and Shane Huffman won on more than one occasion. Huffman went to Victory Lane in 2001 and 2004; Gordon won in 2003 and 2005; and Jeff Agnew won in 2001 and 2002.
- On three occasions in the 15 races at Jennerstown, the driver that won the pole has gone onto win the event.

However, the last time anyone accomplished that feat was in 2004.

- No winner in the 15 events at Jennerstown has ever started worse than 16<sup>th</sup>, which is where Joe Gaita started in his 2005 win.
- Shane Huffman holds the record for the most laps led by a winner. In 2001 win, Huffman led a stout 212 of the 250 laps en route to victory. On the other hand, Jeff Agnew holds the record for least laps led by a winner. Agnew led just one lap in his 2001 victory, beating Brian Vickers to the finish by .010 of a second. The victory was also closest finish in Pro Cup history at Jennerstown.
- On average, the winner at Jennerstown has started 6<sup>th</sup> and led 103 laps.
- Jeff Agnew will be the only driver in the field that has competed in all 15<sup>th</sup> events at Jennerstown Speedway. In those 15 starts, Agnew has posted two wins, six top-5 and 11 top-10 finishes.
